Looking for...

- **Access to patient populations to test behavioral interventions**
 - ▣ **Primary care is ideal for studying prevention behaviors**
 - ▣ **Desire efficient recruitment options**
 - ▣ **Patient portals offer new avenues for research**
- **Access to patient data (EMR, scheduling, billing) to ease recruitment and abstract outcome data (often expected by grant reviewers)**
- **Clinical collaborators who may bring a new content area to examine or a new patient population**
